Fabric Notes

10/2014: Repaired fabric and repainted the entire airplane.

10/2006: Rudder re-covered, wings removed, inspected. Left and right butt and tip ribs replaced, left spar replaced, both wings re-covered (Poly-Fiber). All surfaces re-covered.

9/1993: removed wings and rudder for repair, re-covered (Poly-Fiber), and reinstalled.

7/1986: entire plane re-covered (Ceconite 101), wood replaced as needed, steel frame re-painted. Various fabric repairs throughout the logs.

Broker's Notes

- All logs back to new (photocopies of the original logs)
- Paint in 2014 (8/10), interior (8/10)
- No major damage history noted although various minor repairs have been made as would be expected on a banner tow plane and trainer.
- Prop strike 2/2016. Engine was repaired and converted to an IO-320-E2A (from a -A2B) and Lycoming SBs 505B (crank corrosion) & 475C (crank gear) were completed as well as numerous internal components replaced.
